## KEYNOTE PRESENTERS



### **Jason R. Pickett, MD, FACEP, FAEMS**

Dr. Pickett serves as the Chief Deputy Medical Director for the City of Austin and is an affiliate faculty member in the Department of Surgery and Perioperative Care at Dell Medical School at the University of Texas at Austin and is the Assistant Program Director for the EMS fellowship. Dr Pickett

is a member of the Guidelines and Practice Committee for the National Association of EMS Physicians and is also a member of the Guidelines Committee for the Committee on Tactical Emergency Casualty Care. He serves as the Tactical EMS Chair for the National Tactical Officers Association. Dr. Pickett is Board Certified in Emergency Medicine and Specialty Board Certified in Emergency Medical Services. Prior to his position in Austin, Dr. Pickett served as the Director of the Center for Prehospital and Operational Medicine at Wright State University. He is currently a Battalion Surgeon in the Army National Guard.



### **James Augustine, MD, FACEP**

Dr. Augustine currently serves as the Medical Director for Lee County EMS in Fort Myers, Florida. He also is the Chief Medical Officer for North Collier Fire Rescue in Naples, Florida, and the Greater Naples Fire Control District. Jim is the Medical Director for Washington Township Fire Rescue near Dayton, Ohio.

Jim began his career in EMS when he was in medical school in Dayton. He became a firefighter in 1982, then began his service as a Fire EMS medical director in the Dayton area in 1987. After serving as the President of the Regional Fire EMS council, he became the first Chair of the Ohio EMS Board. He moved to Atlanta in 2001, and served as Medical Director for Atlanta Fire Rescue, including Hartsfield Jackson Atlanta International Airport Fire Rescue division. He later served as Assistant Fire Chief and Medical Director for the District of Columbia Fire EMS Department. While there, he also served as Medical Director for the Metropolitan Police Department.

Dr. Augustine is an emergency physician, and a clinical Professor in the Department of Emergency Medicine at Wright State University in Dayton, Ohio. He is Chair Emeritus of the National Clinical Governance Board for US Acute Care Solutions, based in Canton, Ohio. He is a member of the NAEMSP, and is a key member of the “EAGLES” group of Fire EMS Medical Directors.

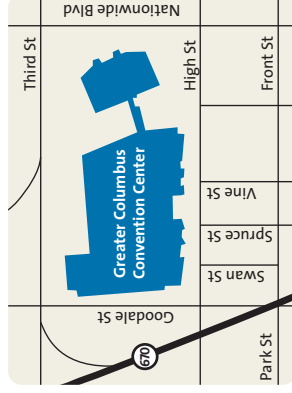
